CONCOURS MONDIAL DE BRUXELLES – SAFETY MEASURES

Dear Sir, Madam and valued judge,

You have confirmed that you will be taking part in the next **Concours Mondial de Bruxelles** due to take place at the start of September in the Czech Republic. We sincerely thank you for your trust and your loyalty to our event.

In order to guarantee your stay is enjoyable and stress-free, the Concours Mondial de Bruxelles is introducing **a raft of strict safety measures**.

- To limit the risk of contamination by Covid-19, competition judges will come **exclusively** from European countries or those that have only been marginally affected by the virus.
- As soon as you arrive, protective **masks** and **alcohol-based hand sanitisers** will be provided for you. Signs will explain the useful **precautionary measures** and remind you of mandatory social distancing requirements. You will be required to wear a mask in all public areas.
- All **meals** will be sit-down or outdoors and access to buffets will be strictly organised. Food will be served by trained staff.
- **Travel will be limited** to the absolute minimum and activities will be organised in small groups. As the hotel infrastructures are located opposite the tasting hall, judges will travel to and fro on foot. The lunches will also be held at the exhibition centre itself.
- The **tasting sessions** will be organised as in previous years according to Concours Mondial de Bruxelles procedures. Each judge will be given an **individual table** and a work area that scrupulously complies with social distancing requirements. The wines will be served by trained staff wearing gloves and masks.
- Any movement around the tasting hall will be organised, strictly limited and masks will be mandatory.
- A **monitoring and tracing system** will be used by the organisers.
- **Medical support** will be permanently available at the venue for all participants.

The entire team at Concours Mondial de Bruxelles and all its Czech partners in South Moravia are doing their utmost to ensure you have an enjoyable stay and to allow you to experience some memorable moments, whilst putting your safety first.
