The Concours Mondial de Bruxelles will take place at the end of June

It's now official - the organisers of the Concours Mondial de Bruxelles, in conjunction with their partners and the Czech authorities, have decided to postpone the competition until 26 to 28 June 2020.

In light of events related to the spread of the Coronavirus (Covid-19) in Europe and across the globe, along with travel restrictions resulting from this health emergency, the Concours Mondial de Bruxelles has been postponed to a later date. The decision aims to guarantee the tastings will run smoothly and that a responsible approach is taken to travel restrictions in a bid to limit the spread of the virus.

Consequently, and on the proviso that the situation improves, the Concours Mondial de Bruxelles will be held in Brno from 26 to 28 June 2020.
